Scripture Reading: Matthew 7:1-5 Speaker: Adam Pogue

We live in a society certainly full of disobedience to God. But, no matter how bad another's sin seems to be, one sin is not worse than another. Sin is sin. To God sin is "lawlessness" (1 John 3:4) and a rebellion against Him (Deuteronomy 9:7; Joshua 1:18). Romans 6:23 tells us "the wages of sin is death." It does not say the wages of *some sins* is death. Though our emotions may tell us horrible acts of hatred or sin are worse than our sins, may we "consider the plank in your own eye" so that we may all teach others about Christ and one day receive our own reward!

  - 2) "He saved others; Himself He cannot save" vs. 42
  - 3) "He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him" vs. 43

  - 1) Chief Priest "Let the Christ, the King of Israel, descend now from the cross, that we may see and believe." vs. 32
- C. Luke 23:35-37
  - 1) Soldiers "If you are the King of the Jews, save Yourself."
- D. Presence of Mary (John 19:25)

## 2) Consider The Plank

- A. While Partaking of the Lord's Supper (1 Corinthians 11:26-29)
  - 1) Unworthy Manor = Guilty of the Body & Blood of Jesus
  - 2) Unworthy Manor = Judgment
- **B.** In Our Actions
  - 1) Luke 14:25-27
  - 2) 1 John 2:6 "6 the one who says he abides in Him ought himself to walk in the same manner as He walked."
- C. When We Return to Sin
  - 1) Hebrews 6:4-6 "6...they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame."
  - 2) Hebrews 10:26-31 "<sup>29</sup>...who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing..." (2 Peter 2:20-22)
