- 1) Why Is Belief Left Out?
- 2) "repent AND ... be baptized..."
- 3) Salvation Requires More Than Faith & A Changed Heart.

3) Acts 9:1-18

A. Question: "What Do You Want Me To Do?"

Answer: "Arise and Be Baptized"

- 1) Was Saul/Paul Saved Upon Belief?
- 2) Upon Repentance? (Acts 9:9,11)
- 3) Upon His Changed Heart? (Acts 9:6; Acts 22:13-15)
- 4) Upon His "I Think So...?" (Acts 26:9-11)

4) Acts 16:25-33

A. Question:"What Must I Do To Be Saved?"

Answer: "Believe" "Were Baptized"
