# An Introduction To: CHURCH DISCIPLINE

1 Corinthians 5:6 - Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise), <sup>3</sup> SO THAT IT MAY BE WELL WITH YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH. <sup>4</sup> Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

- "We urge you, brethren, <u>admonish</u> the unruly, <u>encourage</u> the fainthearted, <u>help</u> the weak, <u>be patient</u> with everyone." **1 Thessalonians 5:14** 
  - 3) Done without consistency (James 2:1-9)
