# 1) <u>Be A God First Giver</u>

# A. Proper Attitude (Luke 12:29-34)

 <u>Would be willing to</u>: Sell what you possess for God; Give what you possess to the poor; Have faith that God would provide if you gave to Him liberally (v.29); Place your heart where it needs to be (v.34)

### B. Proper Faith (Luke 12:22-28)

- 1) Our budgets may show us our faith!
- C. Warnings About Giving Leftovers (Malachi 1:6-10)
  - <u>Warnings</u>: Respect Him (v.6); The leftover offerings are unacceptable (v.7-8); God can be displeased with our offerings (v.10)

# D. Closing Thoughts on Becoming a "God First Giver":

- 1) Why be content with our current standard of giving?
- 2) A "God first giver" will consider what God has said about giving:
  - Old Law 10%
  - New Law Sell whatever you have (Mark 10:21); Widow gave "all that she had" (Mk. 12:44); "Seek first" (Matthew 6:33); "sows bountifully" (2 Corinthians 9:6)

### A. Arguments For Not Giving A Certain Purposed Percentage:

- 1) Finances can be unpredictable
- 2) Giving a percentage is fiscally dangerous
- 3) That is too much money for the elders/ preacher.
