1) Take Divorce Off The Table

- **A. God Hates Divorce** (Malachi 2:16, Hebrews 13:4)
 - 1) What about Jesus' words in Matthew 5 & 19?
 - *Adultery* is the exception & an option, not a command.
 - Even if *adultery* is involved God still hates divorce.
 - 2) Marriage should be for life. (Romans 7:2-3)
 - 3) Divorce without remarriage is not God's will. (Ephesians 5:22, 25)
- B. How To Take Divorce Off The Table?
 - 1) Resolve Conflicts (Ephesians 4:26)
- 2) Forgive One Another (Ephesians 4:32)
- 3) Never let the "D" word come out of your mouth!

2) Spouse First Mentality

- A. Have an Ephesians 5 Heart
- B. Show Appreciation (Proverbs 18:22)
 - 1) Find his/her "love language"
- C. Respect Your Spouse (1 Peter 3:1, 7)
 - 1) Be an Attentive Listener 2) Make Eye Contact
- 3) Be Willing To Help

3) Avoid Hurtful Words

- A. Strive to Remove the Deadly Poison (James 3:3-8)
 - 1) Remove the words "always" & "never"
- 2) Don't set "fires" during a fight
- 3) Do not compare to another spouse or your family
- 4) Watch compliments regarding the opposite sex
- B. Edify Your Spouse (Ephesians 4:29-32)

Notes:

4) Be Willing To Work

- A. "...what God has joined together, let not man separate." (Matthew 19:6)
 - 1) Start with yourself

- 2) Be honest with one another
- 3) Be ready to change as needed to "not separate"
- B. Have a Christ Like Attitude (Philippians 2:3-8)
