



5 Points on Marriage, Divorce and Remarriage

- •You are not to divorce your mate (Matt. 19:4,6)
- •Only exception is sexual immorality/adultery (Matt. 19:9)
- •Those who have been divorced are not to remarry (Matt. 5:32)
- •Those who have divorced their mate for a reason other than adultery are not to remarry (Matt. 19:9)
- •Those who have divorced their mate for adultery may remarry (Matt. 19:9)
