


Foregoing Opportunities to Serve

Devoted Themselves To Prayer

- Colossians 4:2 Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.

Devoted Themselves To Prayer

- Romans 12:12 Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.
- O 1 Corinthians 7:5 Do not deprive one another, except perhaps by agreement for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer; but then come together again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

○ 1 Corinthians 15:1-2 Now I make known to you, brethren, the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand, (2) by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain.
