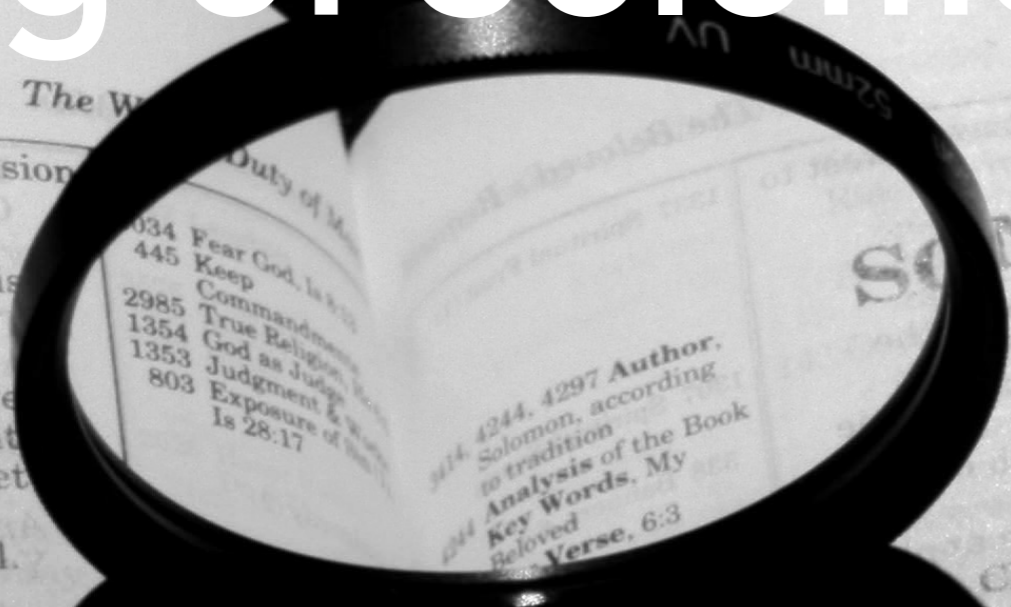

- There is some disagreement as to what the Song of Solomon actually is.
- There is no religious overtone or undertone throughout the entirety of the song besides a reference to God in 8:6.
- There is no mention of Song of Solomon anywhere in the New Testament.
