


What I Noticed When I Read Paul's Letter To Philemon

Philemon (recipient)


Apphia (possible wife of Philemon)

Paul appeals to him on behalf of his runaway servant & now disciple of Jesus, Onesimus.


Paul appeals that Philemon would receive his slave back as a brother in Christ.

Paul shows his love for Onesimus by taking on responsibility for any harm previously done by his running away.

He expresses confidence in Philemon's obedience to Paul's appeal concerning his reception of Onesimus.

Paul states that he hopes to be freed so that he might visit.
