This capital city of Asia Minor was located about a hundred miles north of Ephesus.

It was the cultural, educational, & religious center for all of Asia Minor.

Pergamum was situated on a large 1,000 foot tall hill.

We do not know the origins of the church in this city, but it could have been established during Paul's time in Ephesus when all of Asia heard the Gospel.

The ancient city of Pergamum no longer exists, and its ruins can be found near the modern day Turkish city of Bergama.
