Lessons to Learn from Israel's New Beginning:

1) God Is Forgiving

A. Exodus 34:5-9

- 1) Now is the time to repent & let God place your sins in the past.

B. V. 9: "Pardon" - an act of officially saying that someone who was judged to be guilty of a crime will be allowed to go free and will not be punished. (Merriam Webster)

- Romans 6:23 (1 John 1:9; John 1:12)

2) God Has Requirements

A. Exodus 34:10-11

- 1) God can do "awesome" things through His people if...
- 2) "Observe what I command you this day."
 - The command begins in v. 11 and is brought up again in Deuteronomy 28.
 - Blessings of Obedience – Deut. 28:1-2, 13-14
 - Punishment of Disobedience – Deut. 28:15, 45-47, 58-59

B. What Are Our Requirements?

- 1) Love God above everything. (Matthew 22:36-38)
- 2) Keep His commandments (John 14:15)
 1. Acts 2:38 - Repent & be baptized
 2. Romans 6:1-6 – Die to sin
 3. Galatians 2:20 – Live for Christ
 4. Matthew 22:39 – Love your neighbor
 5. Ephesians 2:10 – Be a worker

3) God Desires 100%

A. Exodus 34:12-17

- 1) V. 13: "you shall destroy" idols
 - Did they "destroy" and obey 100%? (Judges 1:21-33. 2:1-17)
- 2) When we do not give 100% obedience it not only affects our relationship with God, it affects future generations. (Romans 6:14-16, 22)

4) God Is The Light

A. Exodus 34:29-32

- 1) Moses' face "shone" because he was in the presence of God.
- 2) Because of the evidence of God's light the people came to him to seek Godly answers.
