- A. Exodus 34:10-11
 - 1) God can do "awesome" things through His people <u>if</u>...
 - 2) "Observe what I command you this day."
 - The command begins in v. 11 and is brought up again in Deuteronomy 28.
 - Blessings of Obedience Deut. 28:1-2, 13-14
 - Punishment of Disobedience Deut. 28:15, 45-47, 58-59





A. Exodus 34:12-17

- 1) V. 13: "you shall destroy" idols
 - Destroy to cause (something) to end or no longer exist. (Merriam Webster)
 - Did they "destroy" and obey 100%? (Judges 1:21-33. 2:1-17)
- When we do not give 100% obedience it not only affects our relationship with God, it affects future generations. (Romans 6:14-16, 22)
