Matthew 10:32-33 - "Therefore everyone who confesses Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven."

3) Jesus Conquered The Devil

- A. Who Sways This World? (1 John 5:19; Ephesians 6:12)
- B. Remember When You Have Been Deceived (2 Corinthians 11:14; 1 Peter 5:8)
- C. He Defeated The Devil For Us (Hebrews 2:14; 1 John 3:8; Colossians 2:15)

Notes:

Mark 16:16 - "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned."

What must I do to be saved?

<u>Hear</u>: Romans 10:17, Acts 2:37. <u>Believe</u>: Hebrews 11:6, Acts 18:8. <u>Repent</u>: Matthew 4:17, Acts 17:30-31. <u>Confess</u>: Mat. 10:32-33, John 11:25-27. <u>Be Baptized</u>: Mat. 28:19, Acts 2:38, 1 Peter 3:21.
