Church Discipline in The Scriptures

A. Defined:

- 1) Merriam-Webster Punishment, Instruction. Training that corrects, molds, or perfects the mental faculties or moral character. A rule or system of rules governing conduct or activity.
- 2) Thayer's Greek Lexicon 3809 "paideia":
 1. The whole training and education of children (Eph. 6:4). 2. Whatever in adults also cultivates the soul, esp. by correcting mistakes and curbing the passions; hence a. instruction which aims at the increase of virtue (2 Tim.3:16) b. chastisement, chastening,...: (Heb.12:5).

B. Practical Application:

- Regulations set forth by God that Instruct Us, Correct Us, Reprimand Us, Equip Us to begin to be conformed to the image of Jesus our Christ & Savior! (2 Timothy 3:16-17; Romans 8:28-31)
- 2) Preventative In Nature 2 Tim. 4:1-5
- 3) Corrective In Nature Matthew 18:15-17

1) Church Discipline in The Scriptures

- 1 Corinthians 5:5 "that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus."
- Matthew 18:15 "If he hears you, you have gained your brother."
- 2 Thessalonians 3:14 "that he may be ashamed."
- Galatians 6:1 "you who are spiritual <u>restore</u> such a one in a spirit of gentleness,"

1) Church Discipline in The Scriptures

- C. Purpose Of Church Discipline:
 - It Is Not: an act of revenge.
 It Is Not: to be done in spite.
 It Is Not: to embarrass.
 - 2) It Is Designed To:
 - Save The Erring Christian:
 - Protect The Church: 1Cor. 5:6-7; 1 Tim.1:19-20
 - Preserve The Integrity of The Church: 1 Cor. 1:22-23

2) Conduct Deserving of Church Discipline

- A. Scriptural Reasons to Act:
 - 1) A brother who has sinned against another, but refuses to repent of his transgression (Matt. 18:15-17).
 - 2) Those who cause others to stumble, and who initiate division (Rom. 16:17; Titus 3:10).
 - Those who practice such sins as fornication, covetousness, extortion, idolatry, drunkenness, etc... (1 Cor. 5:9).

2) Conduct Deserving of Church Discipline

- A. Scriptural Reasons to Act:
 - 4) Those who teach false doctrines (1 Tim. 1:19-20; 2 Tim. 2:16-18).
 - 5) Those who walk disorderly are to be refused association by the faithful (2 Thess. 3:6).

Closing Thoughts...

- Eldership Should Lead:
 - 1 Corinthians 5, Paul speaks to all the brethren of the church, not just the eldership.
 - It is an activity on the part of the entire church. (Mat. 18:15-17)
