



1) Chosen Vessels of God

A. Abram (Gen. 12:1-4; 16 & 17)

- 1) The command: *"Get out of your country..."*
- 2) The results: Promise Land, Great Nation, From your family *"all the families of the earth shall be blessed."*

Abram/Abraham did not need to be perfect to be a "fellow worker" with God

1) Chosen Vessels of God

B. Moses (Exodus 3:10 – 4:18)

- 1) The command: Go to Pharaoh so I can *"deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians,"* (v.8)
- 2) The results: God's people will be delivered from oppression, They will be led to the promised land

Moses did not need to be a great public speaker to be a "fellow worker" with God

1) Chosen Vessels of God

C. 12 Spies – Caleb & Joshua (Numbers 13:17 – 14:38)

- 1) The command: Go spy out the land & the inhabitants. Be of good courage.
- 2) The results: Only those who trusted God's strength were rewarded.

Caleb & Joshua did not need to be stronger than the enemy, they simply needed to trust God

1) Chosen Vessels of God

D. Esther (Esther 3:2-9, 11, 13; 4:7-16; 7:3-6, 9-10; 8:1, 7-8)

- 1) The command: *“go in to the king to make supplication to him and plead before him...”* (4:8)
- 2) The results: King Ahasuerus said *“Hang him”* and the Jews were saved.

Esther did not need to be scared of what could be done on earth, she just needed faith.

2) Don't Miss Out!

- A. You don't need to be perfect to be used by God. (Phil. 3:12-14)
- B. You don't need to be an expert to be used by God. (Rom. 12:4-8)
- C. You don't need to be strong, just be strong in God. (Phil. 4:6; 2 Tim.1:7)
- D. You don't need to be scared, just have faith in God. (Mat. 10:28)
