- B. This does not mean the husband is allowed to be a tyrant or the wife is a doormat. (1 Cor. 13:5)

- A. Philos - friendly, a friend
 - 1) Means... You want to be with them. You will do what is best for them
 - 2) Does Not Mean... You let them do whatever. You will not punish (Proverbs 27:6)

- A. Different Translations - discreet (NKJV), sensible (NASB), sober (Young's Literal), sober minded (ESV)

- A. For The Sake of Your Husband
 - 1) Spirituality (1 Peter 3:1-4, 7)
 - 2) Marriage Relationship (Hebrews 13:4)
 - 3) Other Christian Men (Matthew 5:28)
- B. For The Sake of Your Children (Ephesians 6:1)
 - 1) Spiritually
 - 2) Physically
