A. Hinder The Work of God (Mark 16:15-16)

- 1) Old Testament: Achan (Joshua 6:18-19; 7:1-13, 19-21)
- 2) New Testament: Adulterous Marriage (1 Corinthians 5:1-8)

B. Hinder My Prayers For Others (Isaiah 59:1-2; Proverbs 28:9; James 5:16)

C. Can Influence Others to Sin (1 Corinthians 5:1,6)

D. Destroy My Influence (Romans 2:21-22)

E. Hurt This Community (Psalms 9:17; Proverbs 14:34; Leviticus 18:1-5, 24-25; Romans 1:32-2:1)

F. Give Enemies of God a Reason to Blaspheme (Romans 2:23-24; Matthew 5:16)

G. Make Others Ashamed of Me (Ephesians 5:11-12; 1 Corinthians 5:13; Ezekiel 16:23-27)
