1) To Worship

(Ephesians 4:15-16)

A. "To Hold Fast the Confession of Our Faith" (Hebrews 10:23; 1 Timothy 4:1-2)

- 1) Endurance is key to Christianity (James 1:2-4,12; Hebrews 10:36)
- 2) Faithfulness is key to Christianity (Proverbs 3:1-5)

B. "To Stir Up Love And Good Works" (Hebrews 10:24-25)

- 1) Let us consider one another. (Romans 12:10)
- 2) Vs. 25 – "exhorting one another"

C. To Continue "Steadfastly in the Apostles Doctrine" (Acts 2:41-42)

- 1) Assembling is not a spectator event
- 2) Failing to continue could lead to spiritual death (Hebrews 10:26-27)

- 3) Each Christian needs to be a light (Romans 12:2)

- 1) God instructs us to be there for one another (1 Thess. 5:9-11, 14-15)
- 2) To show love (1 Peter 4:8-10; John 13:35)
- 3) To help sharpen one another
