





Ekklesia = Church

- a gathering of citizens called out from their homes into some public place; an assembly
- any gathering or throng of men assembled by chance or tumultuously (Acts 19:32, 39, 41)
- an assembly of Christians gathered for worship (1 Cor. 11:18; 14:19, 34, 35)
- A company of Christians (Acts 5:11; Acts 8:3; 1 Corinthians 4:17; 1 Corinthians 6:4; Philippians 4:15; 3 John 1:6; Acts 8:1; Acts 11:22; Romans 16:1; 1 Corinthians 4:17; 1 Corinthians 6:4; Revelation 2:1, 8)

1) To Worship


A. "To Hold Fast the Confession of Our Faith" (Hebrews 10:23; 1 Tim. 4:1-2)

- 1) Endurance is key to Christianity (James 1:2-4, 12; Heb. 10:36)
- 2) Faithfulness is key to Christianity (Prov. 3:1-5)



Proverbs 3:1-5 (ESV)

My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments, ² for length of days and years of life and peace they will add to you. ³ Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart. ⁴ So you will find favor and good success in the sight of God and man. ⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding.

B. "To Stir Up Love And Good Works" (Hebrews 10:24-25)

- 1) Let us consider one another.
(Rom 12:10)
- 2) Vs. 25 – "exhorting one another"



1) To Worship

C. To Continue "Steadfastly in the Apostles Doctrine" (Acts 2:41-42)

- 1) Assembling is not a spectator event
- 2) Failing to continue could lead to spiritual death (Heb. 10:26-27)
