1) Different Standards Lead To Different Results

A. A Subjective Standard Can Lead To Change.

- 1) Subjective – “relating to the way a person experiences things in his or her own mind. Based on feelings or opinions rather than facts.”

B. A Objective Standard Leads To Consistency.

- 1) Objective – “based on facts rather than feelings or opinions : not influenced by feelings.”
- 2) But Isn't the Bible Just a Loose Guide? (Hebrews 13:8; 1 Peter 4:11; 1 Corinthians 14:37-38; 2 Timothy 3:16-17)

A. Ephesians 4:4-6

- 2) God Never Speaks to “my faith,” “your faith,” or “different faiths.”

3) One May Believe A Lie & Be Lost

A. A Prophet of God Was Killed For Following A Lie (1 Kings 13)

- 1) 3 Rules From God: do not eat bread, nor drink water, nor return to Judah the same way you came.
- 2) “The man of God” disobeyed and followed the lie. The result is found in v. 24.
- 3) Galatians 1:6-8

4) One May Lack Knowledge & Be Lost

A. Disciples of Jesus Lacked Knowledge and Needed to Change to Be Obedient to God (Acts 18:24 – 19:5)

- 1) Apollos taught only the baptism of John (18:25)
- 2) Paul instructed them to make a change and be baptized into Christ (19:4-5)
