## The Bible Consistently Condemns The Proud & Prideful

*"Everyone with a proud heart is detestable to the Lord; be assured, he will not go unpunished."* (Proverbs 16:5)

*"Pride comes before destruction, and an arrogant spirit before a fall."* (Proverbs 16:18)

### The Problems With Pride

*"There are two kinds of pride, both good and bad. "Good pride" represents our dignity and self-respect. "Bad pride" is the deadly sin of superiority that reeks of conceit and arrogance.
