The Circumstances Of Psalm 11

- In a moment of trial, David is told to run away from the situation in order to find peace and safety. (vv.1-3)
- Instead of running, David acknowledges God's awareness and power over the situation. (vv.4,5)
- David has full confidence that God will bring about justice for those who have been faithful to Him. (vv.6,7)

The Lessons We Learn

- The righteous solution to the instability of this world is not to shrink away in fear or flee from this world.
- God is well aware of what is taking place in this world, and He will hold each person accountable for their actions.
- We can live peacefully in knowing that God's promises remain firm even if the world is falling apart.
